Week 1: CITY MAYOR & CHURCH LEADERS



"I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people - for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior." 1 Timothy 2: 1-3

Pray for:


- Bristol mayor Marvin Rees, who is a Christian, as he seeks to draw churches into the heart of serving the city

Week 3: UNITY AMONG BELIEVERS

"Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves." Philippians 2:1-3

Pray for:

- Churches to work together humbly to present the gospel well to every part of the city
- That the increasing fellowship and prayer among church leaders across the city would continue



Week 2: DIGGING WELLS OF REVIVAL

"Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? Show us your steadfast love, O Lord, and grant us your salvation." Psalm 85: 6-7

- Thank God for the rich history of revival in the city, such as the preaching of George Whitefield and John Wesley, the work of George Muller, the social reforms of Hannah More, and many more
- Pray for God to raise up many other pioneers of faith
- Ask for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit that will revive the churches and lead many thousands of people to Christ
- Pray for God to raise up those who will commit to praying and fasting for breakthrough in the city

Week 4: TRANSFORMATION OF SOCIETY

"The crowds with one accord paid attention to what was being said by Philip when they heard him and saw the signs that he did... so there was much joy in the city." Acts 8: 6,8

Pray for:

- Hearts to be softened and people to 'pay attention' to the preaching of the gospel
- People not only coming to Christ but being transformed in a way that affects the culture and society around us
- Christians to be at the forefront of creativity, culture, politics, business, etc
- Prosperity for the city and people breaking out of the cycle of poverty
